Nearby Romsey has excellent road links via the M27 or M3 & a good rail service from London Waterloo, with a journey time of around 1 hour. A small train service then links to Romsey from

either Southampton Central or Parkway Stations.

We operate a free shuttle bus from Romsey Railway Station between 08.30am and 09.30am to make travel to Dunwood easier,

returning any guests after the conference too. Nearest airport is Southampton which serves many UK and European destinations and has a direct rail link to Romsey too.

Directions

Travelling south on M3 from the north or from London? Whilst you can cut across country, it may be best to take the M27 towards Bournemouth (NOT Portsmouth) and come off at Junction 2 then follow the directions below. It's worth noting that there are good services at Junction 4 on the M27 and also a McDonalds and fuel/co-op just after you come off the M27 at Junction 2.

From M27 Junction 2. Travelling east or west Come off the carriageway, up the slip road onto motorway roundabout and follow signs to ROMSEY. At the next roundabout turn right passing the Texaco/McDonalds entrance. Follow the dual car-

riageway towards Romsey. You will go up a small hill. Just over the brow, look for a left turn into **Gardeners Lane**. At the end of Gardeners Lane, turn left onto the A27. You will pass the "Blue Hayes" restaurant, then pass the sign for entering SHOOT-ASH. Look for a right turn signposted for AWBRIDGE/KENTS OAK, just past an HGV garage. You will also see a sign for Dunwood Oaks Centre in the left hand verge. Move into the centre of the road and turn right into Danes Road. Follow Danes Rd until you see a sign for Dunwood Oaks Centre directing you to the left turn into our drive. At the end of the drive, come through the brick pillars and our car park is in front of

you. Look out for our car park staff.

N.B. If you miss the left into Gardeners Lane, carry on and at foot of next hill turn left onto A27. Pick up these directions again at the "Blue Hayes" Restaurant.

From Salisbury Travel along the A36 until you see a left turn signposted for Romsey. Take that turn. After 5 or 6 miles you will see on the left "Dunwood Manor Nursing Home". Ignore this. You will start to climb a hill which sweeps to the left. At the top of the hill is a signpost for Awbridge, Kents Oak and 'Dunwood Oaks Centre' Turn left into Danes Road. Follow Danes Rd until you see the signpost for the left turn into our drive. At the end of the drive, come through the brick pillars and our car park is in front of you.

Conference Times

Registration will commence at 9.30am with prompt 10am start to the day. We will stop for breaks throughout the day and have lunch around 1pm. (Please remember to **bring a packed lunch**). The day will end around 4.30 to 5pm.

some questions answered:

So what has Sozo Ministries International got to offer me?

A Word based ministry with concise, accurate, anointed and Holy Ghost led prayers of authority and deliverance, as well as a ministry that keeps a holy Godly order in the midst of deep deliverance. Established now for over 30 years, Sozo has been ministering freedom from freemasonry for nearly 20 of those years. We have a significant range of

other teaching area's especially on subjects such as; wholeness, generational problems, deliverance from occult issues, foundation building, healing, cultures & religious backgrounds, relationships etc. These area's and many other topics all hinge on the importance of praise, worship and the ultimate authority of God's Word.

What will happen on the day?

On the day we will minister thoroughly regarding freemasonry and the other lodges and groups that we feel necessitate prayers of authority. We have found it very effective to look at all the aspects of freemasonry - the vows, oaths, de-

gree's, regalia etc and pray specifically into those area's. We will also minister with regards to the effects of other lodges and brotherhoods, as led. Throughout the day we will stop for comfort-breaks as well as lunch and refreshments. All del-

egates will be expected to fully participate in the day and must be able to commit to the whole day. It is not possible to attend for parts of the day as that could have a negative effect on the person receiving.

Why can't I pray about it myself? Why can't I pray to set myself free?

Our experience has shown this to be an ineffective way of ministry. Due to the very deep spiritual holds that freemasonry and the other lodges and groups have on

people's lives, we believe it requires quite deep and specialised prayer ministry from ministers with knowledge and experience. It is also essential that those ministering are

totally free themselves. Some people who have tried to minister to themselves in the past have often regretted it!



What if someone else has ministered to me in the past? What if I've been through renunciations in a book or self-deliverance manual?

We would not wish to denounce anyone else's ministry, but you have to ask yourself these questions. Have you seen a significant breakthrough in your life? Do you still see things going wrong in your life or the lives of

those around you? Do you still struggle in your daily walk with God? Do you struggle with a physical or spiritual problem that you can't seem to get a breakthrough from? We have been told that

we deal with freemasonry and the other lodges and groups in a deeper way than most other ministries. Wouldn't you like the reassurance that it is dealt with and that you shouldn't need to be ministered to again!

What if it was my husband's or wife's side of the family that was involved, not mine?

Again, our experience has shown that due to the covenant made between husband and wife, the problems associated with

freemasonry and the other lodges and groups tend to affect both sides of a family not just the side that was involved. This then affects

children and their children etc, until all roots and effects have been prayed through.

What kind of things would I expect to see as 'fruit' of the curse of freemasonry?

That's a hard question to answer but in trying ...you may see; A history of breakdowns in relationships or communication within relationships. Members of families unable to accept Jesus Christ in a personal way, especially men. A

real struggle to 'find' a relationship with God. A history of gynaecological or obstetric problems, especially barrenness or miscarriages. Members of the family suffering from undiagnosable or untreatable illnesses. A history of early

deaths, especially through accident or cancer. A history of mental illness or problems with the mind. Poverty, when "on paper" things should be fine ... TO NAME BUT A FEW!

What if I do not know of any lodge history in my family, but my life doesn't seem blessed?

Many people have come in faith with the same dilemma, but have often returned home completely

set free and in a new walk with Jesus. It seems that many people from a religious or strong denomina-

tional background get set free too!

Are there other specific areas of ministry I'd need following this day?

Sozo has a number of key ministry areas, especially in dealing with foundational issues, roots and problems. We would thoroughly recommend taking in some other conference themes/meetings as soon as you are able.
